10th World Congress on Itch

IFSI presented a symposium on Chronic Pruritus and Prurigo at the Global Education Day 2019 of the AAD (American Academy of Dermatology) meeting on Thursday, February 28th, 2019. There was an excellent turnout with more than 50 attendees. The symposium was generously sponsored by Galderma, Menlo Therapeutics and Trevi Therapeutics.

Itch Special Interest Group (SIG) in IASP

Many members of IFSI are also members of IASP, the International Association for the Study of Pain. Sarah Ross and Earl Carstens recently spearheaded an initiative to establish a special interest group (SIG) for itch which has now been accepted by IASP. The SIG is currently in the process of establishing a steering committee and applying to hold a symposium on itch (clinical and basic science) at the 2020 World Congress on Pain, to be held in Amsterdam, Netherlands August 4, 2019.

HOME VII (Harmonising Outcome Measures for Eczema)

HOME meeting was held from April 8-10, 2019 in Tokyo. Toshiya Ebata as an official representative of IFSI gave a presentation on the update of itch measurement on behalf of the SIG, which is lead by Sonja Ständer. As the result itch intensity was decided to be a separate outcome measure in the symptom domain and NRS-11 for peak itch in last 24 hrs (Yosipovitch 2019) was recommended.
